Market Steer Exhibitor?

• Many of our market project exhibitors use the earnings from the sale of their project to further their education in college and/or technical school.

• The quality of meat purchased is unmatched, as the market animals have been given the best care available.

• After the auction, the animal is transported to a processing facility, and you won't have any other responsibility except to pick up your meat and enjoy it!!

By the Numbers....

A 1,000 lb. steer purchased for \$5.00/lb. = \$5,000

As a BUYER you could...

- Put your meat in the freezer and enjoy it throughout the year - just thaw, cook and serve!
- Cook this up and serve it at a company party.
- Sell raffle tickets for the cut and wrapped meat and pick a winner of 1/4, 1/2, or the whole amount.
- Give the cut & wrapped meat away to your employees as a bonus or incentive.
- Share your purchase with a friend or neighbor, split the cost of this fresh product.
- If you aren't able to eat the meat or have a BBQ - local charities are available for a tax-deductible donation

DID YOU KNOW?

A 1,000 lb steer yields... 430 lbs. of Retail Cuts

(Cut & wrapped meat to be brought home)

- Sirloin – 38.7 lbs.
 - Sirloin Steak
 - Stew Beef & Ground Beef
- Short Loin – 34.4 lbs.
 - Porterhouse Steak
 - T-Bone Steak
 - Stew Beef & Ground Beef
- Flank – 17.2 lbs.
 - Stew Meat & Ground Beef
- Rib – 38.7 lbs.
 - Rib Steaks
 - Stew Beef & Ground Beef
- Short Plate – 30.1 lbs.
 - Stew Beef & Ground Beef
- Chuck – 107.5 lbs.
 - Chuck Roast
 - Chuck Steak

We will have cut and wrap prices for you prior to the sale as well as current Resale Prices for our steers.

How can YOU help?

By becoming a “BUYER” you are helping these young Agricultural Leaders in a BIG way! Your options as a “BUYER” are:

Option 1 –

Purchase the Steer during the LIVE Auction.

*Steer is taken to the harvesting facility, processed and ALL meat is returned to you, the BUYER.

* Additional costs involved:

- Processing (Cut & Wrap) Fee from processor
- Deep Freezer for storage

Option 2 –

Purchase the Steer during the LIVE Auction and RESALE the steer.

*Steer is taken to processor and is resold at Market Price.

*You, the BUYER, receive a “Rebate” back for the value of that resale.

Option 3 –

Purchase the Steer during the LIVE Auction and DONATE the meat of the animal.

*Steer is taken to the harvesting facility and processed.

*You, the BUYER, cover the Processing (Cut & Wrap) Fees from the processor.

*Meat is donated to a charity, organization, etc for use.

Option 4 –

Purchasing the Steer during the LIVE Auction and DONATE the RESALE MONEY.

*Steer is resold at Market Price.

*You, the BUYER, chooses a charity, organization etc for that the resale money be donated to.

If becoming a “BUYER” isn't something that you or your business can do at this time...Consider giving an “ADD-ON” to an exhibitor. This is a monetary donation, of any amount, that can be given directly to the exhibitor, or it can be given through the fair. This helps the exhibitor cover the costs they have incurred with their project.
